Eligibility

Businesses in the following Tees Valley local authority areas can apply:

- Darlington
- Hartlepool
- Middlesbrough
- Redcar and Cleveland
- Stockton-on-Tees

Additional Information

The Tees Valley Business Growth Investment Scheme is a £2.4m fund which offers between £25,000 and £250,000 of grant support to small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs) looking to invest in their business to achieve sustainable growth.

Grants can be used to:

improve or expand your premises

- invest in research and development
- to invest in new plant, equipment and machinery
- cover the cost of new staff whose jobs have been created as a result of a capital funded project

You must be creating new permanent jobs in order to qualify for a grant although safeguarding existing jobs will be taken into account.

This grant is similar to the old GBI/SFI Grant, **Finance 4 Business have a 100% success rate** with applications that they were involved in making to these schemes.

Our fees for grant applications are 5% of the grant offered to you or £3,000 whichever is the lower. **If you don't get a grant offer you don't pay.**
